**PETER'S PENCE COLLECTION**

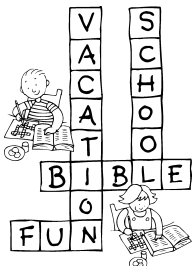
Next week our diocese will take up the Peter's Pence Collection which provides the Holy Father with the assistance he needs to carry out his most important charitable works.
