KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS FOUNDER'S DAY

The Knights of Columbus began in the basement of St. Mary's Church in New Haven, CT, when in 1882 Fr. Michael J. McGivney called together a small group of Catholic laymen to found a society dedicated to providing financial assistance for widows and orphans. This Monday, March 29th, marks the 128th Anniversary of the Knights receiving their original charter from the state of Connecticut.

Cascade Council #9617, that is associated with St. Mary Magdalen Parish/St. John Mission was established on August 6, 1987. DIVINE MERCY NOVENA AND DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

Divine Mercy Novena: April 2nd—April 10th

Recitation of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy following the Stations on Good Friday and daily from 3:00—3:30PM Holy Saturday through April 10th.

Feast of Divine Mercy—Sunday, April 11th, 2010

*"Holy God, Holy Might One, Holy Immortal One
Have Mercy on us and the whole world"*

The soul that will go to Confession [beforehand] and receive Holy Communion [on the day] shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which grace flows are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter.

Blessing and public veneration of the Divine Mercy image at each Mass. In the Parish Hall, following the noon Mass, the movie Ocean of Mercy will be shown., which examines the lives of St. Faustina Kolwalska, St. Maximilian Kolbe, and Pope John Paul II, modern day "Apostles of Mercy." There are brief scenes of the World War II Concentration camps in this 1 hr documentary.

In the church at 2:30PM following the movie: Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, reading and homily, history of the devotion, recitation of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy (9th day of novena), prayer/Benediction. For more information, contact Carla Phillips at 425-353-1204.
