During the Parish Picnic on July 25th, the Office of Religious Education will be running a special "Quilting Corner." We will be making squares that will be sewn into lap quilts for the residents of assisted living facilities.

We are asking for donations of :

- Pre-washed material cut into 12" squares
- Backing material 45" X 1 1/2 yards
- Quilt batting material
- Special fabric paints to paint designs on the squares

People will be designing and painting squares for each quilt. Each quilt will be made of 50% hand-designed squares and 50% printed material squares. Therefore, half of the material needs to be plain, light colors or white for the squares that will be painted.

The Basics of SCRIP

SCRIP is a fundraising program for St. Mary Magdalen School. For each SCRIP card purchased, the school receives a percentage of the purchase value. The vendor's percentage given to the school varies. SCRIP cards are just that – gift cards. You can purchase them for **groceries** (Fred Meyer, QFC, Safeway, Albertson's, etc.), **gas** (ARCO, Chevron, Shell, Mobil/Exxon, Texaco), **clothes** (Eddie Bauer, Gap, LL Bean, etc.), **restaurants** (Alfy's Pizza, Anthony's, Lombardi's, Starbucks, etc.), **home improvement and department stores** (Home Depot, Lowe's, Macy's, Office Depot, Office Max, etc.), and a multitude of other vendors. SCRIP is an easy way to raise funds for the school. Check out your options on Sundays after the 10 o'clock Mass!
