IS GENESIUS AN APPROPRAITE BAPTISMAL NAME? HOW SHOULD A BAPTISMAL NAME BE CHOSEN?

Present Canon Law (855) says simply, "Parents, sponsors and the pastor are to see that a name foreign to a Christian mentality is not given." Certainly, Genesius is not foreign to Christian sentiment.

Actually, there are said to have been four saints who bore the name Genesius: Genesius of Arles, a catechumen martyred after refusing to transcribe an edict ordering the persecution of Christians; Genesius, bishop of Clermont; Genesius, bishop of Lyons; and—legendarily—Genesius the Comedian (actor) traditionally listed as patron of actors.

There is some doubt that Genesius the Comedian really existed. And the same story about an actor who experienced a conversion on stage in the midst of burlesquing the sacrament of baptism and was then martyred by order of the emperor Diocletian (284-305) is told about three other persons besides him.

Since there are certainly at least three saints by the name of Genesius, it is indeed a saint's name. If a connection to the arts is the important thing, St. Catherine of Bologna is a patron of artists and painters. Saint Cecilia is a patron of poets and musicians. Saint Gabriel and Saint Clare are of patrons of television and television workers and Saint Lucy is a patron of writers.
